The award includes \$750 to be used towards academic or internship requirements, a complimentary one-year MAHTN membership, complimentary admission to the Annual Conference, and an assortment of MAHTN swag. All documentation is due to Jeannette.Glennon@jefferson.edu by midnight MAY 30th.

To be considered for the scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- Live, work or attend classes in the MAHTN region (NY,NJ, PA)
- Be enrolled in a horticultural therapy program, or working on an internship, apprenticeship or employment (1 year since last class) and be pursuing horticultural therapy as a career
- Applications must be typed into fill-in PDF and returned by email to Jeannette.Glennon@jefferson.edu
- Request letter of recommendation from professor, internship or work supervisor (within last 3 years)
- Scholarship applications will be read and objectively scored by a panel composed of three experienced Horticultural Therapist
- Scoring is based on: Education, Experience, Career Goals, and Letter of Recommendation

Application must be downloaded and filled in (typed). Save your answers and return application to Jeannette.Glennon@jefferson.edu (change document name to your name). Have your letter of recommendation sent to <u>Jeannette.Glennon@jefferson.edu</u>. Application and Letter of Recommendation are due by midnight MAY 30, 2023.

The Linda M. Ciccantelli Memorial Scholarship

"The Linda M. Ciccantelli Memorial Scholarship" was created in 2007 by the Mid Atlantic Horticultural Therapy Network (MAHTN), to provide financial aid and encouragement to students interested in pursuing a career in horticultural therapy. It is intended to aid students with costs for educational or internship expenses on their path to a career in horticultural therapy.

Linda M. Ciccantelli is considered a pioneer in the practice of horticultural therapy (HT). She originated the well-known HT program at Magee Rehab Hospital in Philadelphia, PA, in 1976, taught HT at Temple University for many years, and made significant written contributions to publications and textbooks for students. Linda served on the American Horticultural Therapy Association board of directors for ten years and was a founding member and president of the Delaware Valley Chapter of AHTA, which later became the Mid-Atlantic Horticultural Therapy Network we know today.

Linda was passionate about Horticultural Therapy and enthusiastically shared her knowledge and experience with students. When she passed away in 2007, The Mid-Atlantic Horticultural Therapy Network memorialized her contributions to the field by naming this scholarship in her honor.

One of MAHTN's guiding mission points includes promoting and supporting horticultural therapy education. To that end, we are proud to offer this scholarship each year to one or more students pursuing horticultural therapy as a profession.
